- Recognize impending respiratory failure and shock.
- Initiate treatment based on the patient's physiologic status as identified by rapid cardiopulmonary assessment:
 - Provide basic and advanced airway management skills
 - Obtain vascular access
 - Initiate appropriate fluid and pharmacologic therapy.
 - Stabilize and evaluate the trauma victim
 - Initiate the first ten minutes of pediatric resuscitation
 - Triage the patient to definitive care
 - Participate in simulation training, using patient simulators
 - Provide support for patients, families, and fellow providers in coping with a child's critical illness, injury, and potential death.
