NIPS (Neonatal Infant Pain Scale)

- The NIPS scale is to be used for term infants from birth to 30 days of age.
- Each of the 6 categories, which consist of 5
 behavioral and 1 physiological indicators, can result
 in a total score between 0 and 7 based on a 1 minute interval of measurement.
