## MN In-Person TRAINING INSTRUCTIONS



<b>Pre-Requisite</b>	You MUST have <b>levels 1, 2, &amp; 3 of the online NA courses completed</b> in entirety before attending in-person training.
<b>Purpose</b>	This is a training day to learn hands on skills. <b>This is not a testing day.</b> We will practice the skills in the Minnesota Headmaster Nursing Assistant Candidate Handbook.
<b>What to Wear</b>	Properly fitting Professional Scrubs and Name Tag (worn on right shoulder). Hair should be neatly combed, out of the eyes and long hair should be pulled back. Closed-toe shoes. Jewelry should adhere to the GSS Dress Code.
<b>How to Prepare</b>	Read the <b>entire</b> Minnesota Headmaster Nursing Assistant Candidate Handbook prior to coming to skills day. <b>What to Bring</b>	Paper and pen/pencil to take notes.
<b>Lunch</b>	You will be given a ½ hour for lunch. We recommend you bring your own lunch. There are refrigerators and microwaves available for you to use.
<b>Training Day Activities</b>	We will review and practice all skills located in the MN Candidate Handbook. We will discuss ways to prepare for state testing.
